Explanatory Notes to the various sections of this Form

For the purposes of this Form:-

Parts ACDE&F

“relevant person” means that a pecuniary interest is a ‘disclosable pecuniary interest’ in relation to you, or it is an interest of yourself or:

- i. your spouse or civil partner,
- ii. a person with whom you are living as husband and wife, or
- iii. a person with whom you are living as civil partners and you are aware that the other person has the interest.

“relevant period” means 12 months ending with the day on which the Member gives the notification.

Part C - Contracts

“body in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest” means a firm in which the relevant person is a partner or a body corporate of which the relevant person is a Director, or in the securities of which the relevant person has a beneficial interest.

Parts DE&F

“land” excludes an easement, servitude, interest or right in or over land which does not carry with it a right for the relevant person (alone or jointly with another) to occupy the land or to receive income; and

Part G – Securities

“securities” means shares, debentures, debenture stock, loan stock, bonds, units of a collective investment scheme within the meaning of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 and other securities of any description, other than money deposited with a building society.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- 1) Details of your notified interests will appear in the Members’ Register of Interests and be open to public inspection. They will also be published on the Authority’s website.

- 2) If you consider that the disclosure of the details of any of your interests could lead to you, or a person connected with you, being subject to violence or intimidation and you would like to withhold these details from the register of interests, please provide this information to the Monitoring Officer and explain your concerns regarding the disclosure of the sensitive information, including why it is likely to create such a risk. If the Monitoring Officer agrees, the information will not be included in copies of the register made available for inspection, or any published version of the register.

Part A: Employment

Any employment, office, trade, profession or vocation carried on for profit or gain.

Part B: Sponsorship

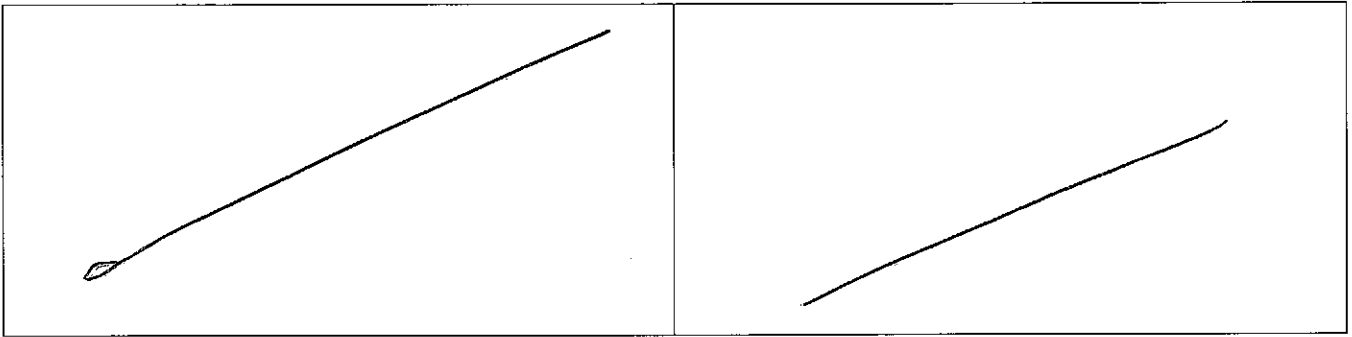

Part I – Declarations

IMPORTANT

It is a criminal offence to fail to notify the Monitoring Officer of any Disclosable Pecuniary Interests (DPIs). This requirement arises in each of the following circumstances:

- a) before the end of 28 days beginning with the day on which you become a Member or co-opted Member of the Authority (s.30(1) *Localism Act 2011*);
- b) where the DPI is not entered in the Authority's register and is not the subject of a pending notification but is disclosed at a meeting of the Authority (or any committee, sub-committee, joint committee or joint sub-committee) as required by s.31(2) of the Localism Act, within 28 days beginning with the date of the disclosure (s.31(3) *Localism Act 2011*).

It is also a criminal offence to knowingly provide information that is false or misleading (or being reckless as to whether the information is true and not misleading).
