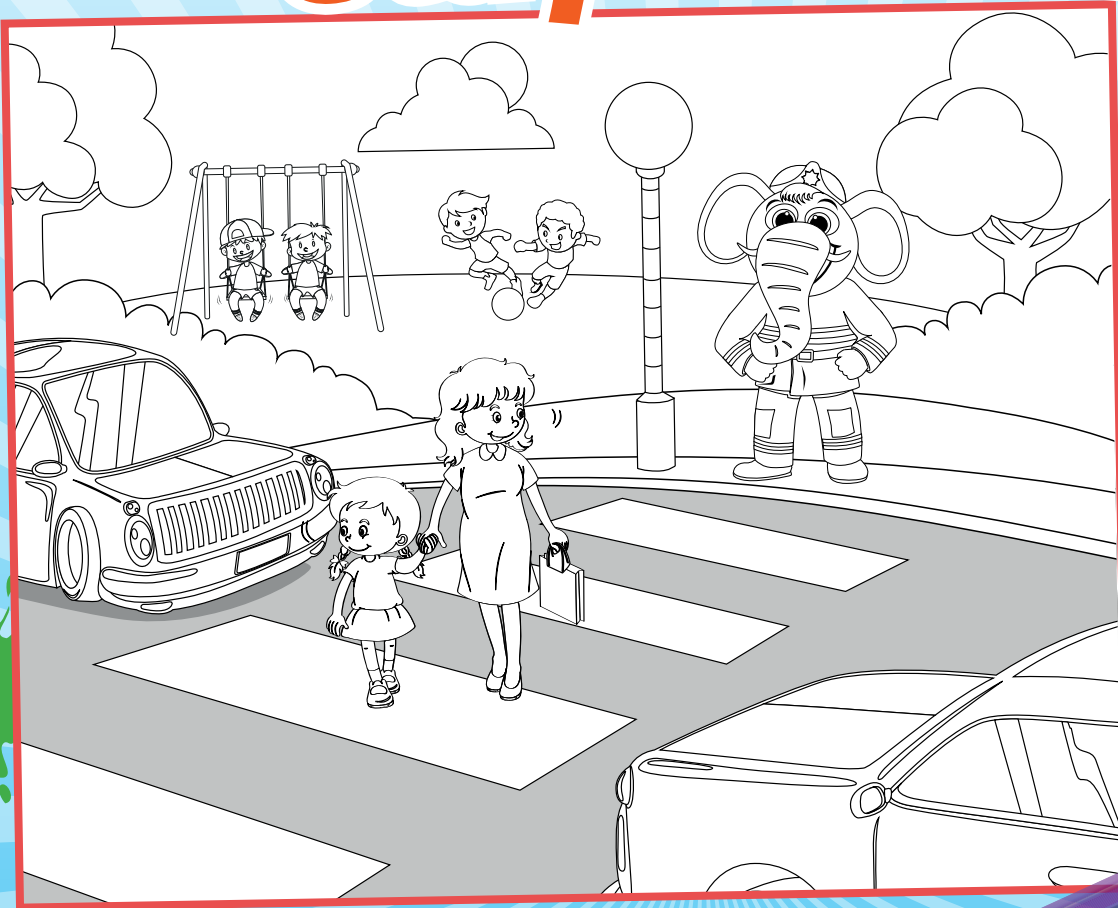


Play Safe, Stay Safe

Remember the following tips when you are out and about:

- Traffic can be dangerous – always hold hands with the grown up that you are with near roads
- Play safely away from traffic – such as in a park or garden
- Find the safest place to cross a road, then stop at the kerb, look and listen for traffic before crossing
- If there is a zebra, toucan or pelican crossing or a subway near always use it when crossing the road
